Part 6. Our Enemy

Lesson 3: The Heavenlies - Understanding the Unseen Realm of Spiritual Conflict and Victory

Lesson Summary

The "heavenlies" (Greek *epouranios*) refer to the unseen spiritual realm described in Ephesians: where Christ is seated (Eph. 1:20), where believers are positioned with Him (Eph. 2:6), and where spiritual warfare occurs (Eph. 6:12). This realm is real though invisible, as seen when Elisha's servant's eyes were opened to angelic armies (2 Kgs. 6:17). Satan operates here with organized ranks—principalities, powers, rulers, and hosts of wickedness—though his defeat was secured at the cross (Col. 2:15). Scripture presents three heavens: the first (atmosphere, Gen. 1:6–8), the second (outer space and battleground of spiritual forces, Eph. 6:12), and the third (God's dwelling place, 2 Cor. 12:2). Fallen angels include both unbound demons active on earth (Luke 8:30; 2 Cor. 4:4) and bound angels confined in Tartarus for grievous rebellion (2 Pet. 2:4; Jude 6). Christ reigns supreme above all rule and power (Eph. 1:20–21), and believers share His authority. Though battles rage, Satan's final judgment in the lake of fire is certain (Rev. 20:10). The call is to live with awareness, vigilance, and confidence in Christ's victory.
